

THE VICTORY AC AROUND HAYLING RELAY - CLOCKWISE

Leg 12 Route 2.3 miles

Texaco Petrol Station to Field near St Peter's Churchyard

(SPLIT CHANGEOVER - A MARSHALL WILL GIVE YOU A BATON.)

Start south of the Texaco petrol station which is on the SE corner of the junction of Havant Road and Northney Road. Run south along the pavement on the left (east) side of the Havant Road. Take care crossing the junctions of New Cut and Avenue Road.

Opposite the Esso petrol station by the telephone and letter boxes, turn left into Victoria road, and continue heading east to the end of the road. At the end, turn left on to a footpath going north behind houses. It is straight and comes out at a road junction. Cross the road and keep going straight north on the pavement on the left side of Kingsway.

At the top the road turns left. Cross the road here and continue north on a footpath to the right of a bungalow. It turns right and then left around a World War II pillbox, then passes the pillbox barracks on your left. The path ends at a T-junction - turn right here on to a track.

Pass stables on your left, then go over a stile and continue straight on at the side of a field. You come to some houses on your left then go between a barn and a duck pond to come out on to a main road at a bend. Turn slightly right on to the main Northney Road for approximately 50 metres. **PLEASE TAKE CARE HERE.**

Turn right on to a footpath which runs south along the side of trees on your left. At the end of the tree line, turn left (east) following the line of trees to the rear of some houses. There is a slightly raised path to the right running south behind the houses and on to the entrance to the churchyard. Pass the grave of a Russian Princess (yes we had one living on Hayling). Go through the opening on the other side of the graveyard, bear slightly left and follow the cart track to the FINISH which is at the exit from the fields on to an access track leading to St Peter's Road.
