

## THE VICTORY AC AROUND HAYLING RELAY CLOCKWISE

### Leg 1 Route 2.4 miles

#### Field near St Peter's Churchyard to Woodgason Lane

Heading north on the cart track, towards the churchyard. Bear left just before the entrance to the churchyard.

Follow the track west then south then bear right diagonally until the cart track again, turns towards the south.

At this point there is a path on your right with a gully and a line of trees to the left of it. Continue west along this path. You are now heading west towards one of Hayling's water pumping stations (white in colour) in front and to your right.

Go over the stile then continue straight on, Caution the path was separated from the field on your right, but the barbwire fence has broken down in places and the remnants are on the floor covered by undergrowth. Be careful here tripping up is a possibility. Go through a gate in the hedge and turn right immediately after the gate. Go north to the corner of the water pumping station, over a stile and turn left.

Proceed along the edge of the pumping station and on along the edge of the trees towards the houses.

Turn half right across the field it is taped on both sides separating you, from the horse fields on both sides. The path takes you to the right corner of the field, where there is an exit between the houses. Turning left here and exit out on to the Havant Road.

Turn left down the road, bear left around the bend and continue straight on into Northwood Lane. Proceed east, past the junction with Castleman's Lane on your right into what appears to be a dead end. Continue past some stables on your right and into Northwood Farm, between two concrete barns. In front of you is a path along the side of a field. You are now still heading east towards Upper Tye Farm.

Continue on this path. Near the end, to your left, is an old barn raised up on concrete mushrooms. Then there is an opening on to Cope Lane at a bend in the road. Carefully cross the road here going left. Continue east then north for a few meters until you reach the junction with Woodgason Lane. Turn right into Woodgason Lane.

When you reach the Garden Centre, turn right and continue to follow the road down to the at the end of the road there is a T-junction.

This is the hand over point.
